1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rule as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS) and the International Laser Class Association (ILCA) rules.

1.2 The first paragraph of RRS 40 will be replaced with: "Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices, at all times when on the water, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices."

1.3 The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 This regatta is open to all sailors in Laser Standard, Laser Radial and Laser 4.7 rigs

2.4 All entrants shall start and finish together and each Laser fleet shall be scored separately.

3. ENTRY FEE; REGISTRATION

3.1 There shall be no entry fee.

3.2 Registration: Send an email to ck@oldcoveyc.com indicating your intention to compete.

3.3 All sailors must check-in Sunday morning immediately upon arrival.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available at check-in.

6. RACING AREA

6.1 Competitors will sail a course from Cutchogue Harbor around Robins Island as announced at the skippers' meeting. Three possible courses are listed below.

R26 Starboard

G3 Starboard

Finish

Course Bravo

Start

Windward Set Mark

G3 Port

R26 Port

Finish

Course Charlie

6.2 While the finish line for Courses Alpha, Bravo, and Charlie will be located in the same general area as the start, the Race Committee will not stay on station throughout the race and will set a new finish line.

7. STARTS:

Starts will be 3 minute dinghy starts.

8. SAIL NUMBERS:

Sailors are required to have UNIQUE sail numbers.

9. PROTESTS:

360 turns are required of boats that foul. If you wish to protest you must organize the protest committee yourself. If you foul and don't do your penalty turn you have cheated everyone else and yourself.

10. SAFETY & RESPONSIBILITY:

Sailors are required to wear adequate protective gear & PFD's. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4 (Decision to Race). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

11. SCORING

11.1 Each fleet will be scored separately.

11.2 Prizes will be awarded in each fleet.

12. LOANER BOATS:

OCYC has 3+ loaner boats available. These are on a reserved basis, please contact Chris for reservations.

13. VENUE:

Old Cove Yacht Club is located on the North Fork of Long Island, at 1400 Old Harbor Road in New Suffolk, New York
