

NOTICE OF RACE
SEBAGO CUP - 2021

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
The organizing authority is the Sailing Committee of the Sebago Canoe Club, Brooklyn, NY.

2. ENTRIES

Entries will be comprised of ILCA/Lasers (Full, Radial), Sunfish (race and recreational rigs), and any participating dinghy class with two or more boats of the same class. Boats must be able to fit down the ramp and launch off the dock.

3. FEES

Entry fee for this event is \$20 and includes post racing beer and food.

4. SCHEDULE

Saturday September 25 , 2020

11:00 am - Skippers' Meeting

12:00 pm - Warning Signal, race to follow

5. RISK

It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. (See RRS rule 4). The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all of their actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on shore activities before, during, and after the regatta. All State and Club Covid-19 rules must be strictly followed.

At the discretion of the PRO this race may be canceled for any reason where the PRO feels that conditions are beyond what is considered safe sailing. Due to lack of chase boat support, racers who assist others in need will be scored as to their position when they rendered assistance.

Additionally, any member of the RC or Sebago Canoe Club Sailing Committee may terminate any sailor's participation and mandate that they return to shore for not following the procedures, regulations or for any safety reason. The sailor must comply and retire from the days sailing.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will available the day of the race.

7. COURSES & RACING AREA

The racing area will be Jamaica Bay in Gateway National Recreational Park, Brooklyn, NY

Course will be announced during Skipper's Meeting and will consist of government buoys, moveable balls and islands of Jamaica Bay. Course is approximately seven miles.

8. SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A, will be used.
